GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR THE HIRE OF A MOBILE HOME.

The hire takes place from Saturday 4 p.m. to the following Saturday 10 a.m.

All requests for a booking must be in writing, accompanied by a deposit of 30% and a cheque for $0 \in 0$ for administration costs. A holding deposit of $250 \in 0$ will be requested upon arrival. This will be returned to the client, following an inventory and inspection of the condition of the mobile home the day of your departure, after deductions for possible losses or damage. This deposit does not limit the client's liability. The tourist tax is fixed at $0.15 \in 0.15$ per day/person, payable separately.

The client will receive two copies of the booking contract by post as confirmation.

TRAVELLERS CHEQUES ACCEPTED.

CANCELLATION

On the part of the camp-site In the case of cancellation of a holiday by the campsite for which they are responsible, with the exception of unforeseen disasters, the client will be totally reimbursed.

On the part of the client All cancellations must be in writing. In the case of cancellation more than 30 days before the holiday the deposit will be withheld. Less than 30 days before the start of the holiday, all payments will be withheld. For all late arrivals of which the campsite has not been informed, the mobile home will be considered available for rehire 24 hours after the expected arrival date. After this time limit the booking will be cancelled and all sums will be withheld.

Each Mobile Home is equipped with cooking utensils, cutlery, crockery and bedding (with the exception of sheets).

The equipment is subject to an inventory on arrival and departure. Every tenant is expected to take responsibility for such and to inform reception on the very day of any eventual occurrences.

The cleaning of the Mobile Home is the responsibility of the tenant, a charge of $53 \in$ will be deducted from the deposit if this has not been done.

All tenants are obliged to respect the internal rules of the campsite

Animals must be kept on a lead. Their owners must carry an up to date vaccination certificate.
